

2024 Engineering & Technology Scholarship

Description – a scholarship for textbook and course material reimbursement, in the amount of up to \$750 per year, for up to four (4) consecutive years. This is intended for courses in the pursuit of an undergraduate degree.

Eligibility – must be a high school senior and a student in Paulding County with plans to pursue a bachelors or associates degree in engineering, computer science, or information technology, and must have a minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) of at least 3.0 on a scale where 4.0 is the highest and/or a class standing of no less than the top 30%.

Application – students who meet the eligibility requirements must complete an application form to verify eligibility and submit a written essay as described in the attached application form.

Submission – applications/essays must be received by 5:00 PM on April 12th, 2024. Transcripts must be submitted with the application. Submissions may be made in-person or by email to human.resources@insource.tech.

Selection – interviews of students who are considered finalists will take place between April 15th and April 19th, 2024, and will be conducted by member(s) of InSource management at the school of the applicant.

Recognition – this scholarship will be presented to the selected student at the academic awards night hosted by their high school.
